### Notice for The New School Year Commencement under COVID-19

2-9-2021

Dear Parents,

1. The Education Bureau (EDB) announced that all schools in Hong Kong can arrange face-to-face classes, but for half-day classes only. The new school year commencement schedule is as follows:

K2 & K3	2-9-2021	9:00am	11:00am

2. During the summer holiday, the school has thoroughly cleaned the school campus and sprayed disinfection coating for disinfection, which validity period is for 90 days. Our school staff, school bus/nanny bus drivers and nannies have been urged to strengthen hygiene and epidemic prevention measures to ensure personal and school environmental hygiene. In addition, the school also requires all staff taking care of students (including school bus and nanny bus drivers, as well as those accompanying the bus) to take their temperature before returning to school every day. Any staff who has a fever is not allowed to return to school.
3. The school got a book disinfection cabinet to ensure that the books returned every time can be disinfected before being borrowed by students for the next round.
4. The air conditioner has been thoroughly cleaned to ensure that the ventilation system is clean and disinfected.
5. Equipped with anti-epidemic partitions for students to use when drinking water in the classroom.
6. The school will do our best to maintain campus hygiene and protect the health of students. It is hoped that after the commencement of classes, students will gradually return to their normal school life under safe condition. However, given that the COVID-19 epidemic situation still not stable, the school will continue to monitor the situation closely, and parents should also stay vigilant to the latest announcements by the EDB and the school.
7. Cooperation from parents and students are important for us to maintain a clean and safe environment. We call on your support to step up environmental hygiene in the household, and, on top of that, implement the following measures strictly:
- 7.1 Pay attention to the health condition of your child. He/She should stay away from school and see a doctor immediately if symptom, especially fever, is detected.
- 7.2 Take your child's temperature before he/ she goes to school every day. Fill in the record sheet and sign your name on it. Your child should return the completed sheet to us daily.
- 7.3 To prevent infection, please ask your child to wear a mask (also applicable when taking school buses, nanny vans or other transportations) and bring tissue paper to school every day.
- 7.4 To keep teachers' informed of the health condition of students, please complete (Proforma A) to provide us with the following information:
- travel history of your child outside Hong Kong in the past 14 days;
  - whether your child has confirmed infection of COVID-19;
  - the health status of those taking care of your child, or those living with your child;
  - the current health status of your child.
- Please return the Proforma on or before the first day of class commencement. For those who have contracted the virus and have recovered, if they are still within the 14-day quarantine period, they must not go to school.
- 7.5 After the commencement of classes, you are requested to notify our teacher, immediately in case of any of the following situations, to facilitate our prompt action in taking contingency measures and informing the EDB:
- your child has been confirmed infection of COVID-19; or
  - your child has been classified as "close contact of an infected person" with COVID-19
8. With concerted efforts contributed by different parties, we look forward to overcoming the adversities of the pandemic so that students, teachers and parents can resume normal living and healthy life.
