Notice for Class Resumption Arrangement

April 14, 2022

Dear Parents.

1. The Education Bureau announced that all schools in Hong Kong can arrange half day face-to-face classes. The class resumption schedule of the school is listed as follows:

Class Level	Resumption Date	Class Time	Dismissal Time
K3	3-5-2022	9:00am	12:00nn
K2	10-5-2022	9:00am	12:00nn
K1	16-5-2022	9:00am	12:00nn

- 2. During the class suspension period, the school has fully cleaned the school premises and sprayed disinfectant coating for disinfection, which is valid for 90 days, and has urged all school staff, school bus/nanny van drivers and nannies to strengthen the hygiene and epidemic prevention measures to ensure personal and school environmental hygiene. In addition, the school also requires all staff who taking care of students (including school bus and nanny van drivers, as well as vehicle attendants) to take their temperature every day before returning to school. No staff member will be allowed to return to school with a fever.
- 3. The air conditioner has been thoroughly cleaned to ensure that the ventilation system is clean.
- 4. Anti-epidemic partitions are provided for students to use when they have refreshments and lunches in the classroom.
- 5. The school will do its best to maintain campus hygiene and protect the health of students. It is hoped that after the resumption of classes, students can gradually return to normal school life in a safe environment. However, as the COVID-19 situation may change, the school will continue to monitor the situation closely, and parents should also pay attention to the latest announcements from the Education Bureau and the school.
- 6. For students to study in a clean and safe environment, the cooperation of parents and classmates is essential. We urge parents to strictly implement the following measures in addition to strengthening household hygiene:
 - 6.1 Pay attention to the health condition of your children, if they have symptoms, especially fever, please do not go to school and seek medical advice immediately;
 - 6.2 Measure the body temperature of the children before class every day, and fill in the "Body Temperature Record Card" provided by the school every day. After signing, the students should take the card back to the school;
 - 6.3 All students must complete a rapid antigen test before returning to school every day and can only return to school with a negative result. Parents need to write the test result with the student's name and date, take a photo or put the test prod in a zip-lock bag and bring it back to school for checking at the entrance. Only for students who take the school bus to school, parents need to take pictures of their children's rapid antigen test results, and WhatsApp to the school's phone for the checking by class teacher, so as to prevent students from dropping the test prods on the school bus;
 - 6.4 In order to prevent infection, please urge students to wear masks (when they are on the school bus, nanny van or other public transportation) and bring tissues when they go to school every day;
 - 6.5 If the rapid antigen test result is positive, the student is not allowed to return to the school, you should notify the school as soon as possible and the student should stay at home, you must also report to the Department of Health through the "Declaration System for Individuals Tested Positive for COVID-19 Using Rapid Antigen Test" (https://www.chp.gov.hk/ratp/).
- 7. Arrangement for Full-day classes:
 - 7.1 Students who need to stay in school in the afternoon must receive one dose of vaccine, and must have completed one dose of vaccine on May 15 this year for more than 14 days; and please receive the second dose of vaccine on time. The school will provide meals for students who stay in the school for day care service;
 - 7.2 Parents must submit the afternoon stay application letter and a copy of the vaccination record one week before the resumption of classes:
 - 7.3 Prepare the siesta supplies for Full-day session students.

Remarks: I hope that with the efforts of all parties, we will get out of the haze of the epidemic as soon as possible, all teachers, students and parents will return to normal and healthy lives soon!
